
1st Sunday of Lent (C)

- He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High, and abides in the shade of the Almighty, says to the Lord: "My refuge, my stronghold, my God in whom I trust!" R
- Upon you no evil shall fall, no plague approach your tent.
 For you has he commanded his angels to keep you in all your ways. *R*
- 3. They shall bear you upon their hands, lest you strike your foot against a stone.On the lion and the viper you will tread, and trample the young lion and the serpent. R
- 4. Since he clings to me in love, <u>I</u> will free him, protect him, for he <u>knows</u> my name.
 When he calls on me, <u>I</u> will answer him;
 I will be with him in distress; I will deliver him, and <u>give</u> him glory. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
