



# 1st Sunday of Lent (C)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 90(91):1-2, 10-15. R. v. 15

1. He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High,  
and abides in the shade of the Almighty,  
says to the Lord: "My refuge,  
my stronghold, my God in whom I trust!" *R*
2. Upon you no evil shall fall,  
no plague approach your tent.  
For you has he commanded his angels  
to keep you in all your ways. *R*
3. They shall bear you upon their hands,  
lest you strike your foot against a stone.  
On the lion and the viper you will tread,  
and trample the young lion and the serpent. *R*
4. Since he clings to me in love, I will free him,  
protect him, for he knows my name.  
When he calls on me, I will answer him;  
I will be with him in distress; I will deliver him, and give him glory. *R*

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:  
first played on the organ,  
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;  
it is then repeated after each verse.*
