
3rd Sunday of Lent (C)

- Bless the Lord, <u>O</u> my soul, and all within me, his <u>ho</u>ly name. Bless the Lord, <u>O</u> my soul, and never forget <u>all</u> his benefits. *R*
- 2. It is the Lord who forgives <u>all</u> your sins, who heals every one <u>of</u> your ills, who redeems your life <u>from</u> the grave, who crowns you with mercy <u>and</u> compassion. *R*
- The Lord does <u>deeds</u> of justice, gives full justice to all who <u>are</u> oppressed. He made known his <u>ways</u> to Moses and his deeds to the chil<u>dren</u> of Israel. *R*
- 4. The Lord is compassion and love, slow to anger and <u>rich</u> in mercy. For as the heavens are high above the earth so strong his mercy for <u>those</u> who fear him. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
