
4th Sunday of Lent (C)

- I will bless the Lord <u>at</u> all times, praise of him is always <u>in</u> my mouth. In the Lord my soul shall <u>make</u> its boast; the humble shall hear <u>and</u> be glad. *R*
- 2. Glorify the Lord with me; together let us praise his name.
 I sought the Lord, and he answered me; from all my terrors he set me free. *R*
- Look towards him <u>and</u> be radiant; let your faces not <u>be</u> abashed. This lowly one called; <u>the</u> Lord heard, and rescued him from all <u>his</u> distress. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
