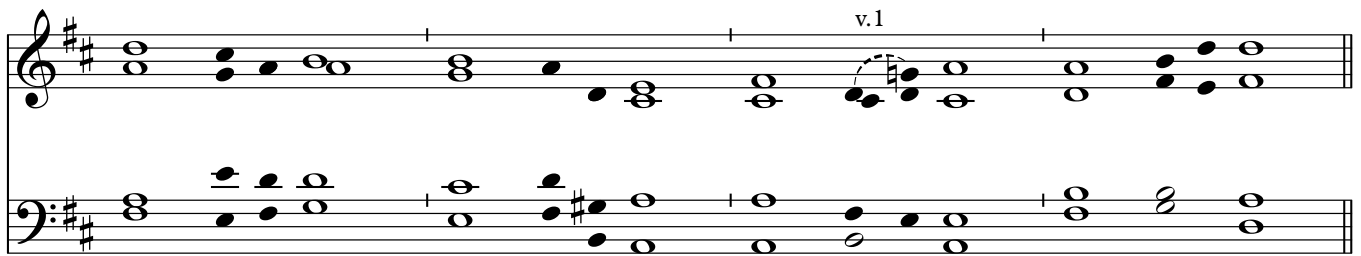


2nd Sunday of Easter (C)

This is the day the Lord has made;
let us rejoice in it and be glad. **R**
3. We beseech you, O Lord, grant salvation;
We beseech you, O Lord, grant success.
Blest is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
We bless you from the house of the Lord;
the Lord is God, and has given us light. **R**

first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
