
3rd Sunday of Easter (C)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 29(30): 2, 4-6, 11-13. R. v. 2

- I will extol you, Lord, for you have <u>raised</u> me up, and have not let my enemies rejoice <u>o</u>ver me,
 O Lord, you have lifted up my <u>soul</u> from Sheol, restored me to life from those who sink into the pit. *R*
- 2. Sing psalms to the Lord, you <u>faithful</u> ones; give thanks to his <u>ho</u>ly name.
 His anger lasts a moment; his favour <u>all</u> through life.
 At night come tears, but <u>dawn</u> brings joy. *R*
- Hear, O Lord, and have mercy on me;
 be my helper, O Lord.
 You have changed my mourning into dancing,
 O Lord my God, I will thank you for ever. R

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
