1. I will extol you, Lord, for you have raised me up,
and have not let my enemies rejoice over me,
O Lord, you have lifted up my soul from Sheol,
restored me to life from those who sink into the pit. **R**
2. Sing psalms to the Lord, you faithful ones;
give thanks to his holy name.
His anger lasts a moment; his favour all through life.
At night come tears, but dawn brings joy. **R**
3. Hear, O Lord, and have mercy on me;
be my helper, O Lord.
You have changed my mourning into dancing,
O Lord my God, I will thank you for ever. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:
first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
