
## 11th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

- 3. Rejoice in the Lord,Exult you just!Ring out your joy,all you upright of heart. R

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
