1. Preserve me, God, for in you I take refuge.
I say to the Lord: 'You are my Lord.
You, you alone are my good.' **R**
2. I will bless the Lord who gives me counsel,
who even at night directs my heart.
I will keep the Lord before me always:
with him at my right hand, I shall not be moved. **R**
3. And so, my heart rejoices, my soul is glad;
even my flesh shall rest in hope.
For you will not leave my soul to Sheol,
nor let your holy one see corruption. **R**
4. You will show me the path of life,
the fullness of joy in your presence,
at your right hand, bliss for ever. **R**
