


14th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

R Cry out with joy to God, all the earth.



1. Cry out with joy to God all the earth,
O sing to the glory of his name.
O render him glorious praise.
Say to God: 'How wondrous your deeds!' **R**
2. 'Before you all the earth shall bow down;
shall sing to you, sing to your name!
Come and see the works of God,
his wondrous deeds among the children of Adam. **R**
3. He turned the sea into dry land,
they passed through the river on foot.
Let our joy, then, be in him;
he rules for ever by his might. **R**
4. Come and hear, all who fear God.
I will tell what he did for my soul.
Blest be God, who did not reject my prayer,
nor withhold from me his merciful love. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:
first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
