
## 15th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

**Responsorial Psalm**: Psalm 68 (69):14, 17, 30-31, 33-34, 36-37. R. cf. v. 33 Robert Gower



- I pray to you, O Lord, at an acceptable time.
   In your great mercy, answer me, O God;
   Lord, answer, for your mercy is kind. R
- As for me in my poverty and pain, let your salvation, O God, raise me up.
   Then I will praise God's name with a song; I will glorify him with thanksgiving. R
- 3. The poor when they see it <u>will</u> be glad, and God-seeking hearts <u>will</u> revive; for the Lord listens <u>to</u> the needy and does not spurn his servants <u>in</u> their chains. *R*
- 4. For God will bring salvation to Zion, and rebuild the cities of Judah.
  The children of his servants shall inherit it; those who love his name shall dwell there. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
