



# 15th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

1. I pray to you, O Lord, at an acceptable time.  
In your great mercy, answer me, O God;  
Lord, answer, for your mercy is kind. **R**
2. As for me in my poverty and pain,  
let your salvation, O God, raise me up.  
Then I will praise God's name with a song;  
I will glorify him with thanksgiving. **R**
3. The poor when they see it will be glad,  
and God-seeking hearts will revive;  
for the Lord listens to the needy  
and does not spurn his servants in their chains. **R**
4. For God will bring salvation to Zion,  
and rebuild the cities of Judah.  
The children of his servants shall inherit it;  
those who love his name shall dwell there. **R**

first played on the organ,  
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;  
it is then repeated after each verse.*
