


# 3rd Sunday of Advent (C)

Responsorial Psalm: Is 12:2-6. R. v. 6

**R** Shout a - loud and sing praise, — you who dwell in Zi - on.

1. Behold, God is my salvation!  
I will trust and will not be afraid,

2. With joy you will draw water from the springs of salvation.  
Give thanks to the Lord, invoke his name;  
Make known among the peoples his deeds;  
proclaim that his name is exalted. **R**
3. Sing to the Lord for he has wrought wonders;  
let this be known through all the earth.  
Shout aloud and sing praise, you who dwell in Zion,  
for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:  
first played on the organ,  
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;  
it is then repeated after each verse.*
