
3rd Sunday of Advent (C)

Responsorial Psalm: Is 12:2-6. R. v. 6

- Behold, God is <u>my</u> salvation!

 I will trust and will not <u>be</u> afraid, for the Lord is my strength <u>and</u> my praise, and he has been <u>my</u> salvation. *R*
- With joy you will draw water from the springs <u>of</u> salvation. Give thanks to the Lord, invoke his name; Make known among the peo<u>ples</u> his deeds; proclaim that his name <u>is</u> exalted. *R*
- Sing to the Lord for he <u>has</u> wrought wonders; let this be known through <u>all</u> the earth. Shout aloud and sing praise, you who <u>dwell</u> in Zion, for great in your midst is the Holy <u>One</u> of Israel. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
