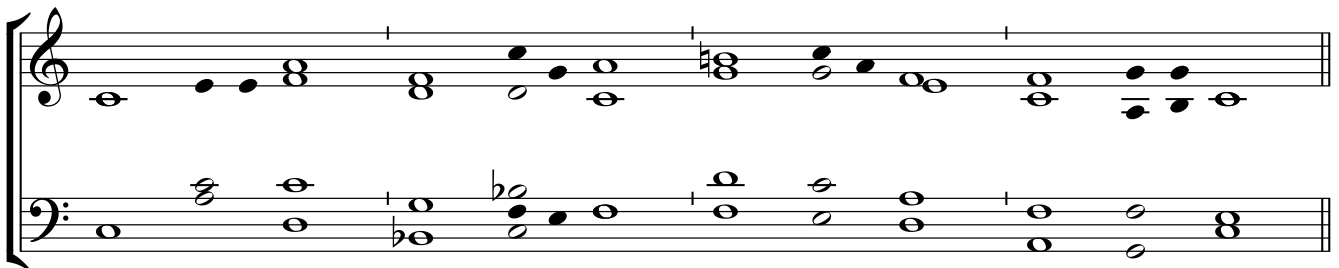
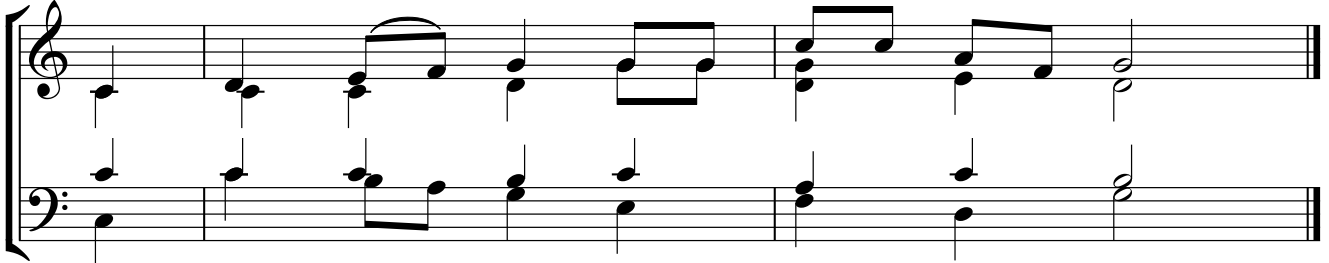


16th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

1. Lord, who may dwell on your holy mountain?
Whoever walks without fault;
who does what is upright
and speaks the truth from his heart. **R**
2. Whoever does not slander with his tongue;
who does no wrong to a neighbour,
who looks with scorn on the wicked,
but honours those who fear the Lord. **R**
3. Who keeps an oath, whatever the cost,
who lends no money at interest,
and accepts no bribes against the innocent.
Such a one shall never be shaken. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:
first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
