

- Lord, who may dwell on your <u>ho</u>ly mountain? Whoever walks <u>without</u> fault; who does <u>what</u> is upright and speaks the truth <u>from</u> his heart. *R*
- 2. Whoever does not slander with his tongue; who does no wrong to a neighbour, who looks with scorn on the wicked, but honours those who fear the Lord. *R*
- 3. Who keeps an oath, whatever the cost, who lends no money at interest, and accepts no bribes against the innocent. Such a one shall never be shaken. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
