
19th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

1. Ring out your joy to the Lord, \underline{O} you just; for praise is fitting <u>from</u> the upright. Blessed the nation whose God <u>is</u> the Lord, the people he has chosen <u>as</u> his heritage. **R**

2. The Lord's eyes are on <u>those</u> who fear him, who hope in his mer<u>ci</u>ful love, to rescue their <u>soul</u> from death, to keep them a<u>live</u> in famine. **R**

3. Our soul is waiting <u>for</u> the Lord. He is our help <u>and</u> our shield. May your merciful love <u>be</u> upon us, as as we hope in <u>you</u>, O Lord. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
