


22nd Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

R In your good-ness, O God, ——— you pre - pared a home for the poor.



1. The upright shall rejoice at the presence of God,
they shall exult with glad rejoicing.
O sing to God; make music to his name;
The Lord is his name; exult at his presence. **R**
2. Father of orphans, defender of widows:
such is God in his holy place.
God gives the desolate a home to dwell in;
he leads the prisoners forth into prosperity. **R**
3. You poured down, O God, a generous rain:
when your heritage languished, you restored it.
It was there that your flock began to dwell.
In your goodness, O God, you provided for the poor. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:
first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
