
## 22nd Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

- The upright shall rejoice at the presence of God, they shall exult with <u>glad</u> rejoicing.
   O sing to God; make music <u>to</u> his name;
   The Lord is his name; exult <u>at</u> his presence. *R*
- 2. Father of orphans, defender of widows: such is God in his holy place.
  God gives the desolate a home to dwell in; he leads the prisoners forth into prosperity. *R*
- You poured down, O God, a generous rain:
   when your heritage languished, you restored it.
   It was there that your flock began to dwell.
   In your goodness, O God, you provided for the poor. R

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
