

- 2. Who is like the <u>Lord</u>, our God, who <u>dwells</u> on high, who lowers himself <u>to</u> look down, to look down upon <u>heav'n</u> and earth? *R*
- 3 From the dust he lifts up the lowly, from the ash heap he raises the poor, to set them in the company of princes, yes, with the princes of his people. **R**

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
