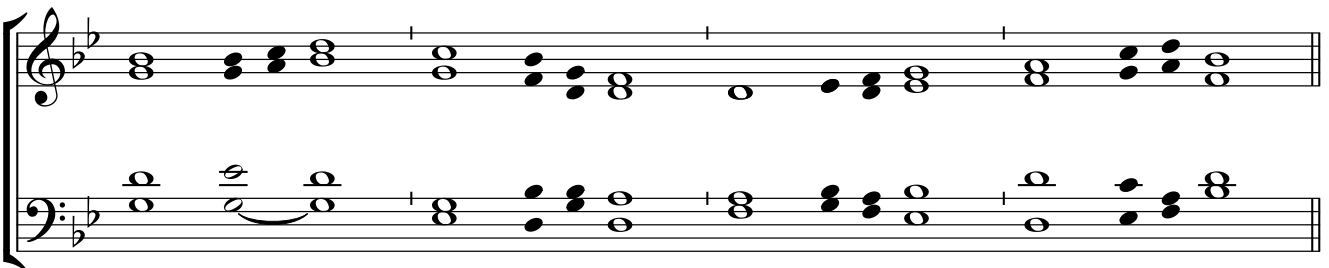


29th Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

Israel's guard. **R**
3. The Lord your guard, the Lord your shade
at your right hand.
By day the sun shall not smite you
nor the moon in the night. **R**
4. The Lord will guard you from evil,
he will guard your soul.
The Lord will guard your going and coming
both now and for ever. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:
first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
