

- O Lord, hear a cause <u>that</u> is just, pay heed <u>to</u> my cry.
 Turn your ear <u>to</u> my prayer: no deceit is <u>on</u> my lips. *R*
- 2. I kept my steps firmly <u>in</u> your paths.
 My feet have <u>never</u> faltered.
 To you I call; for you will surely heed <u>me</u>, O God.
 Turn your ear to me; <u>hear</u> my words. *R*
- 3. Guard me as the apple of your eye.

 Hide me in the shadow of your wings.

 As for me, I shall behold your face in righteousness;

 when I awake, I shall be filled with the vision of your presence. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
