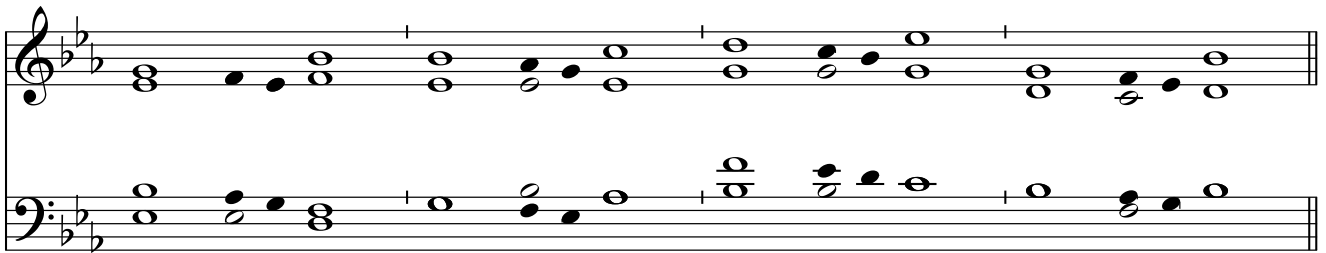
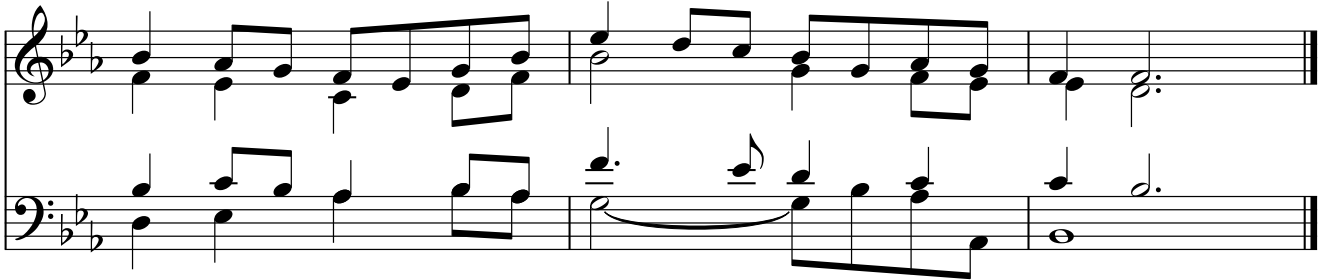


32nd Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

Hide me in the shadow of your wings.
As for me, I shall behold your face in righteousness;
when I awake, I shall be filled with the vision of your presence. **R**

first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
