


33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

1. Sing psalms to the Lord with the harp,
with the harp and the sound of song.
With trumpets and the sound of the horn,
raise a shout before the King, the Lord. **R**
2. Let the sea and all within it thunder;
the world; and those who dwell in it.
Let the rivers clap their hands,
and the hills ring out their joy. **R**
3. Rejoice at the presence of the Lord,
for he comes to judge the earth.
He will judge the world with justice,
and the peoples with faithfulness. **R**

*The refrain is heard three times at the start:
first played on the organ,
then sung by the cantor and repeated by all;
it is then repeated after each verse.*
