
## 33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time (C)

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 97(98):5-9. R v. 9

- Sing psalms to the Lord with the harp, with the harp and the sound of song.
  With trumpets and the sound of the horn, raise a shout before the King, the Lord. R
- 2. Let the sea and all with<u>in</u> it thunder; the world; and <u>those</u> who dwell in it. Let the rivers <u>clap</u> their hands, and the hills ring <u>out</u> their joy. *R*
- 3. Rejoice at the presence of the Lord, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world with justice, and the peoples with faithfulness. *R*

The refrain is heard three times at the start: first played on the organ, then sung by the cantor and repeated by all; it is then repeated after each verse.
